Karen asked Jim Arrison to come to the farm and touch our horses because he has had the Midas touch so far this year. All of Jim's horses are homebred. WILD KAY, 2003 filly by Lionhearted out of Wild Bea, had a win at Laurel Park on December 8th. She added another win at Laurel Park on January 22 when she alternated the lead and fought back for the win. WILD KAY then won an allowance race at Charles Town on May 19th when she set the pace and slowly drew off for a 2 1/2 length win. She had a second on November 11th at Laurel Park as well. LION ON THE RUN, 2006 gelding by Lionhearted out of Blushing Mary, added a win to his record on January 30 with a 5 1/2 win and won again on February 21st. He was second on January 9th, 17th and April 10th. MISTY'S REBELLION, 2007 filly by Lion Hearted out of Misty's Princess, won at Charles Town Race Track on February 19th when she chased the lead and came home with a drive to win. She came in on top again on March 29. FLATTERING ANNIE, 2008 filly by Flatter out of Storming Annie, won an allowance race at Charles Town on March 31st after being bumped at the start then gained in the deep stretch. She came back with a second on May 14th. SECRET LIFE OF BEA, 2007 filly by Domestic Dispute out of Wild Bea, won a Maiden Special Weight at Charles Town on April 2nd when she moved up on the outside and drew off for a 5 length win. MISTY'S SONG, 2008 filly by Domestic Dispute out of Misty's Princess, won a Maiden Special Weight at Atlantic City on April 30th for owner and trainer Crystal Pickett. Not a bad few months! The full brother to FLATTERING ANNIE and the PA bred half sister to WILD KAY and SECRET LIFE OF BEA are in training on the farm and are for sale. Please contact us if you are interested!! Dare to Dream Stables has also had a nice run lately: ILLEGAL INTRUDER by Duckhorn broke his maiden at Parx Racing on March 23rd when he assumed command and was under wraps late to win by 8 1/2 lengths. AP-PEALING DIVA, 2008 filly by Successful Appeal, broke her maiden at Hawthorne on April 22nd when she reserved off the second flight, shifted to the outside and steadily edged for the win. BOSTON POP BAND, 2006 VA bred gelding by Bowman's Band, won a Maiden Special Weight at Atlantic City on May 1st when he drew clear under urging. He also ran second at Philadelphia Park on April 17th. Run A Buck had a second at Laurel Park on December 17th, as did Livingonaprayer at Charles Town on January 6th. If you are interested in getting into a partnership go to www.daretodreamstables.com. Ronald Thoma's homebred, DAN'S GINGER, 2007 by Western Expression, broke his Maiden at Philadelphia Park on November 6th when he quickly established the lead. DAN'S GINGER also won on December 5th at Philadelphia Park when he again took the lead early for the win. GW is Best had a second at Penn National on December 16th, January 10th and again on February 21st. Big Ron West was second at Philadelphia Park on April 19th.

Virginia Breeders Carlos S. E. Moore and Gillian Gordon-Moore's **TRIPLEKIN**, by Makin won the \$50,000 Queen's Cup MPC Chase Hurdle Stakes at Charlotte on April 30th by 5 3/4 lengths.

Dan Borislow bred KYLIECANANDWILL, by Beautiful Indy, who broke his maiden on December 4th at Charles Town for trainer John Scanlan. KYLIECANANDWILL also won at Mountaineer on April 29th. Borislow's DAN'S LAST STAND, by Toccet, broke her maiden on February 15th at Parx Racing. The chestnut filly added a starter allowance win at Atlantic City on May 1st when she lead all the way for a 4 3/4 lengths margin.

BLESSED SOUL, by Perfect Soul (IRE), started on a winning streak with an allowance win on November 5th. She added another on January 21st when she won by 4 lengths, and then widened her win margin to 6 1/2 lengths on April 22nd at Pimlico. **BLESSED SOUL** ran second in the \$50,000 Maryland Racing Media Stakes on February 12th when she just missed by 3/4 lengths. She also had a notable second on December 18th.

Jim Driver's homebred BLUEMONT'S GIRL, 2005 by Way West (FR) out of Bluemont's Affair, won at Charles Town on November 14th by 4 1/4 lengths. She had a second on December 23rd at Charles Town and again on May 11th. BLUEMONT'S PRIZE, 2007 filly by Prized out of Bluemont's Affair, broke her maiden on March 16th after running second at Charles Town on January 13th and on February 26th.

Parker's Charm has been doing well at Charles Town for owner/breeder Stephen L. Reggetts. The Parkers Storm Cat colt was second on November 4th, won on November 18th, second on April 13th, and then won again on January 4th and February 2nd.

ROYAL FIREWORKS, by Bop, broker her maiden at Charles Town on January 8th for local owner Paul M. Brown, Sr. of Hanover, Virginia. The chart says she dug in at the outside of the pacesetter from the head of the lane to win by 2 lengths. She came back with a second in an allowance race on February 15th.

I AIN'T LYIN', a Virginia bred by Yes It's True, won at Parx Racing on November 26th by 11 1/4 lengths. The chart read she set the pace under light rating, was never asked to run, and drew off in the stretch as if out for a stroll in the park. The gray filly came back with a second in a starter allowance on May 2nd at Atlantic City. and another second at Parx Racing on December 13th.

JOHNNY BUBBAKANUSH, 2007 gelding by Duckhorn, broke his maiden at Penn National on December 30th for owner/breeder John Morrone. He also won on February 25th when he lead all the way. His older brother, JOHNNY KING, 2006 gelding by Lil's Lad, broke his maiden at Penn National on January 10th. He had a second on February 11th and April 18th.. JOHNNY KING then lead all the way in a win at Penn National on May 10th.

MOON JAM, by Duckhorn, won at Parx Racing on November 8th when she ran down the leaders.
MY BUDDY GARFIELD, by Buddha, won at Beulah on November 24th and second on November 11th.
STATE REP, by Full Dress Blues, bred by Walter Downey won on January 30th
STAR CITY SLEW, by Evansville Slew, won at Charles Town on March 31st and on April 15th.
DANCED ALL NIGHT, by Jazz Club, won at Charles Town on April 21st.
AGAVE RIDGE, by Cactus Ridge, won on January 17th and on February 2nd at Laurel Park for owners PTK.

Winner of the Calder Handicap, Japan Racing Association Handicap, Delray Stakes and Needles Stakes. He sired Dover Snow, a track record setter, Vallata Lane, Comely Comet, Purple Sand and of course our favorite homebreds Wirt and Toccoa. He was a very special horse. His racetrack groom came to visit him a few times at the farm and past employees always wanted to know how Purple was doing and wanted to visit him. He was a mainstay at Eagle Point Farm since 1985. There was not a dry eye on our farm and he will be missed by all.
