FIRST TIME WINNER: IRISH WARNING won in his first time out in 1:11.2 by 4 3/4 lengths at the Fair Grounds on March 8th. The Larrupin gelding was bred by Jim Ryan Sr., owned by Dan Ryan and trained by Mike Pino.

FIRST TIME WINNER: BLYTHEWOOD, 2000 bay filly by Root Boy won by 1 1/4 length at Charles Town on April 17th. Jeff Runco trains the filly for owner/breeder Mrs. Frank Wright of Maryland.

TALLULAH MAE, 2000 chestnut filly by Allen's Prospect out of Sapor stumbled slightly at the start and slipped thru the rail in an allowance win at Charles Town on January 12, 2003. She is owned and bred by Ryver Meadow Farm and trained by David Walters. Another David Walters Ryver Meadow combination winner is **SNOW LEOPARD**, 2000 colt by Larrupin' who broke his Maiden by 4 1/2 lengths on January 22.



SHIFT CHANGE AT EAGLE POINT

APACHE FLAME won two at Charles Town for trainer Jeff Runco on February 8th and April 9th. Kevin Pipes bred and owned the Foxhound filly. The filly also added a second on February 1st and April 27th.

LIGHTNING ECHO. Ch. G. by Western Echo out of Lillehammer Light broke his maiden at Laurel. Bred by the late Frank Little Lightning Echo stalked the pace, dueled 2 wide through the stretch and narrowly prevailed.

THE OLDIES KEEP ON WINNING:

O'FRED, at age 6 won on February 6th by 1 1/4 lengths in a 6 1/2 furlong race for Owners Nellie Cox and Robert Bouse. This Fred Astaire gelding keeps adding to the win column for trainer Flint Stites.

SPIDER DANCE, Goldlust at age 7 wins another race for breeder Dr. Stanley Tucker of Hanover on February 28th at Penn National and a second on January 25th

FLYING HARLEY, gray gelding age 8 by The Cool Virginian won easily by 5 3/4 lengths at Laurel for breeder Nellie Cox also 2nd on March 1 at Laurel.

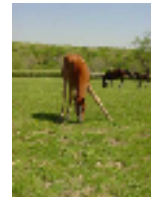

2003 foal crop in Virginia:



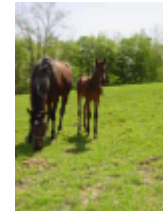
Flower Wolf

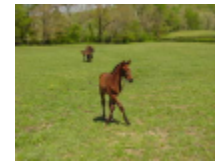
Echo Valley Marfa

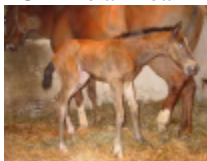
Granann

After a inspection trip to Churchill Downs, **Christmas Away**, 2000 stakes placed gray colt by Skip Away was purchased for client Elmon Gray of Waverly, Virginia. Mike McMahon served as agent. **Christmas Away** ran fourth in the \$100,000 Forerunner Stakes at Keeneland on April 17th for his new owner Elmon Gray under Patrick Bryne, previous trainer and Pat Day in the irons.. The gray horse was shipped to Bowie after the race to his new trainer Robbie W. Bailes.

Bailes also saddled **Scootin' Girl** for owner John Tucker of Vontay who ran 4th in the \$75,000 added Stravinsky Stakes at Keeneland on April 19.. **Scootin' Girl** spent some time at Eagle Point Farm last fall in order to let her down before some R &R at her home after a successful 2002 campaign.
