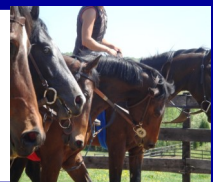

FLATTERING BEA, by Flatter, added another stakes place finish in the \$100,000 Safely Kept Stakes at Laurel Park on November 9, 2013. James Arrison watched his homebred save ground on the turn while well back, eased out entering the stretch, swung wide midstretch and rallied outside to run second. On April 19, 2014, **FLATTERING BEA** stalked the pace off the rail, took the lead and dug in under steady encouragement to hold on for the win in the \$200,000 Sugar Maple Stakes at Charles Town. Way to go Jim!

PURE LADY LIKE, by Pure Precision, earned a stakes placed finish in the \$100,000 Selima Stakes at Laurel Park on September 21st. The two year old filly moved between horses, dropped to the rail, altered out in upper stretch and finished gamely between the top two to lose by a 1/2 length. BCCC Syndicate owns the filly who finished her two year old year with two seconds in allowance races at Laurel Park.

KISSER 'N RUN, by Pleasant Tap, won the \$75,000 Peapack Hurdle Stakes at Fair Hill on October 19th for the second year in a row by a 1/2 length when she was back early, jumped the last with two rivals and had enough left to win. **KISSER 'N RUN** finished the year with another stakes win in the \$50,000 Crown Royal Hurdle Stakes on November 2nd. Her 2013 record of six starts with two stakes wins and two stakes placed finishes earned **KISSER 'N RUN** the Nation Steeplechase Association's Life's Illusion filly and Mare Champion of the year award. **KISSER 'N RUN** started 2014 with another stakes win on April 19, 2014 in the Georgia Cup Hurdle Stakes by 6 1/4 lengths.

ROYAL FIREWORKS, by Bop, showed sharp speed and cleared in the initial yards, controlled the pace and held sway under a drive to win an allowance race at Charles Town on September 6th. She returned with another allowance win on September 28th when she set the pace two wide and repulsed a bid in upper stretch and drove clear. **ROYAL FIREWORKS** finished the year with two seconds all at Charles Town for owner Barbara B. Brown of Hanover, Va. The filly added a second on April 3rd.

MEDAGLIA DE PLATA, by Medallist, won an allowance race at Charles Town on September 13th for owner Kazdan Racing Stables when she rated a short lead on the backstretch, was urged clear then dug in with steady hand pressure to hold on after the jockey lost his whip. The filly was second in a later allowance race and was the one that made a bid to pass Royal Fireworks in the above mentioned race.

GRASSHOPPIN, by Cat Thief, won first time out in a Maiden Special Weight at Parx on April 6th. He raced inside, angled out and advanced into the stretch to be up in a long drive for breeder and owner Michael W. Jester. The colt then ran second in an allowance race next time out on April 22nd.

BLACKSTONE LILY, by Activist, won at Penn National on April 23rd for breeder Judith M. Barrett and Long Stretch LLC.

CATCH THE ACTIVIST, by Activist, broke his maiden by nine lengths at Penn National on April 26th. He stalked the pace from the start, raced along the inside and drew off in the stretch for owner DB and S Racing.

SOUTHERN PARFAIT, by Southern Success, won an allowance race at Penn National on September 20 2013. Slow early, raced along the four path on the turn and prevailed. In easier company at Penn National on January 23rd, **SOUTHERN PARFAIT** won by 10 1/4 lengths when she came out four wide and quickly drew off.

WILD KAY, by Lion Hearted, bred by James Arrison of Virginia has been steady eddie with wins at Parx Racing on September 28th, January 19th and February 2nd and April 7th with four thirds in between.

NAGATAMEN, by Peak Dancer, added two more wins for the year on November 1st, and November 22 at Charles Town. He recorded a second in allowance company on February 2nd for breeder Eagle Point Farm.

SILVER LEGEND, by Horse Greeley, broke his maiden at Laurel Park on January 15th for owner Mountain View Racing LLC. The gelding stalked the pace, raced in the three path, gained the lead and drove clear. He had a game second on November 28th, and April 4th. **SILVER LEGEND** stalked the pace while saving ground and rallied inside and eagerly pulled away for a six legends winner in a Starter Allowance at Pimlico on April 25th.

SALLY OH SALLY, by Sharp Humor, likes Presque Isle Downs as she added her second win on September 25 for owner RMR Stables of Powhatan, Virginia. Sally pressed the pace three wide, bid late and was up in time.

SWEET LIBERTY, by Sun King, broke her maiden for owner and breeder Charles M. Wilson of Ashland Virginia. She stalked the pace two deep, challenged the lead and dug in to take the nod in the final strides at Charles Town on March 19th.

COBBLEY'S PROFIT, by Tom Cobbley, surged clear nearing the three quarter pole, widened her margin and proved much the best with a steady stretch handling to win by 8 1/4 lengths for breeder Heidi B. Overfelt and owner Michael L. Overfelt at Charles Town on March 20th.

Owner, breeder and trainer Charles C. Conaway, Jr. saddled his horse GUSTO AT DAWN, by Buckle Down Ben, to win at Charles Town on February 7th. After settling into midpack while racing two wide he took the lead near the 1/16 pole and edged ahead. He had a second on November 11th at Mountaineer.

GRAND VIZIER, by City Zip, won at Mountaineer Race Track on September 28th and October 20th for owner Tigertail Ranch of Nevada. Both times he dug in to hold off challengers.

KRISTIN'S BIRDIE, by Gunnerside, broke her maiden at Charles Town on September 12th for breeder Stephen L. Reggetts and owner Reggetts Racing Stable. The filly stalked the lead, edged closer and responded when given her cue. She ran second on November 14th.

E. ESPEE, by Changeintheweather, won an allowance race at Penn National on October 11, 2013. E. ESPEE was unhurried and drew off under urging. He added a second on April 19th.

THE BOP EXPRESS, by Bop, won an allowance race at Charles Town on December 21st for breeder Sally Ann Yeckley of Virginia. She added a second on October 5th and on December 21st.

NEXT BEST THING, by Stephen Got Even, won at Parx on December 31st when she vied outside, took over before the half, then remained safe under a steady drive.

GINGER SNAP, by Discreet Cat, broke her maiden on March 27 at Laurel Park for owner Jeevan R. Mathura.

FLATTERING ANNIE, by Flatter, won at Suffolk Downs on September 11th for breeder James Arrison of Virginia and also had a second on December 20th at Laurel Park

LION ON THE RUN, by Lion Hearted, added another easy win on October 9th for breeder James Arrison.

BIG RON WEST, by Western Expression, won at Thistledown on September 27th when he set the pace and shook clear to win for breeders Mr. and Mrs. Ronald Thoma. Another win for the breeders was KAYLAS BUFFY, by Textbook, who won at Mountaineer Park on November 5th by five lengths. She also had three second place finishes to add. ELLIE'S TEXTBOOK had a win on April 7th at Beulah. RUNNINGINFLIPFLOPS, by Textbook, added several wins for the same breeders at Mountaineer RaceTrack on March 4th, April 2nd, and April 26th and was second on November 29th and on December 28th.

CHEOPS, by El Corredor, won at Laurel Park on March 5th and at Pimlico on April 27th for breeder Tigertail Ranch and was second on March 22nd and April 8th
