Two year old stakes winner!

UNAQUOI, by Gattopardo, won the Rachel's Turn Stakes at Charles Town on September 17th for owner and breeder Ray M. Pennington III. The gray filly hustled to the lead inside to set a pressured pace and dug in under steady encouragement to hold on for the win. **UNAQUOI** broke her maiden on August 26th in a Maiden Special Weight and placed second in a Maiden Special Weight on August 19th.



SECRET OR NOT, by Orientate, was stakes placed again when she ran second in the Nellie Cox Stakes on June 25th at Pimlico. She had a second in an allowance race at Laurel Park on July 23rd. Her younger full sister, **NOT A SECRET**, broke her maiden at Laurel Park on August 19th. Both fillies are owned and bred by Charles Wilson of Ashland, Virginia.

MORE WINNERS!

COWBOY'S PRINCESS, by Cowboy Cal, figured out how to win when she broke her maiden at Gulfstream Park on May 11th by a length coming from off the pace. She then added wins on June 12 by 6 1/4 lengths on the front end, July 21 by 3 1/4 lengths just off the pace, and again on August 5th and by 3/4 lengths on the top. For owner Dexter Craigie, Jr.

Daniel W. McConnell Sr.'s, **O AUBREY**, by Rimrod, broke her maiden at Parx Racing on July 12th when she set the pace in the two path, drifted out through deep stretch and lasted by a neck. She came back on July 31st and again set the pace then opened a clear lead and maintained to win by 2 1/4 lengths.

FLASHY KYEM, by Medallist, bred by McConnell, Gelman and Vosters and owned by McConnell and Lee Vosters won an allowance race at Parx Racing on June 6th by a neck. The bay gelding added seconds on August 4th and September 4th in allowance company. Another homebred of Daniel W. McConnell's, **THUNDER DUKE** won at Delaware Park on June 2nd when he ran past the leader to win by two.

Virginia Bred, **TIZ UNBEATABLE**, by Tiz Wonderful, won first time out for owner and breeder Sam E. English II in a Maiden Special Weight at Charles Town on August 4th. The colt chased the pace and steadily improved to take the lead and win by two. Another English horse, **AWAKE THE DAY**, by More Than Ready, had a second at Laurel Park on July 2nd and at Delaware Park on August 6th.

After a disappointing first race, **YASAMIN**, by Misbah, took control of the lead and was never menaced while driving through the stretch to win a \$63,500 Maiden Special Weight at Parx Racing for owner Sharon D. McKenzie and breeder Godstone Farm LP on July 19th. She also rewarded the bettors with a payout of \$108.40! A good day for all involved.

Michael W. Jester's **TACTICAL PLAN**, by Cat Thief, won a Maiden Special Weight on August 7th at Parx Racing when he settled between foes early and advanced outside and then edged clear following a long drive.

WABASH CANNONBALL, by Grand Slam, won an allowance at Evangeline Downs on May 28th and on August 26th for owner and breeder Tigertail Ranch. In the first race he was forwardly placed and proved best in a drive to the wire in a determined fashion to win by a length. In the second win he was reserved early rushed up late down the lane to just get up for the win.

James M. Anderson is the owner and breeder of **TECHNICALLYSPEAKIN**, by Inner Harbour, who won an allowance race at Charles Town on June 30th. The colt settled off the pace, started a bid off the rail and dug in to take over in the final yards.

FAIRY GRAY, by Cat Thief, won a \$25,000 maiden claiming race at Parx Racing on June 7th for owner Wynter Racing Stable when she ran erratic through the stretch but held on under strong handling.

UNCANTMAKEITUP, by Marcavelly, broke his maiden for owner and trainer Howard R. Brown Jr. on April 30 at Parx Racing by 3 1/2 lengths.

THERESA'S HONOR, by Posse, won at Delaware Park on May 21st for owner Felix Susi LLC when she broke sharp, saved ground and won under steady handling.

PUTURSEATBELTON, by Bustin Stones, won at Pimlico on May 26th for owner Pramote Changsila when he was squeezed back leaving the gate but closed between horses and drove clear. The bay gelding won again on June 9th in an allowance race when he closed steadily and was up in time.

ALADDIN'S LAMP, by Misbah, won at Penn National on July 8 for breeder Godstone Farm LP and owner Robert E. Curley and Judith Barrett.

GENNARO, by Cosmonaut, won at Mountaineer Racetrack on May 24th.

ADDED SPICE, by Wilburn, won at Mountaineer Racetrack on May 25th and on September 14th.

AMERICAN TREBLE, by American Lion, won at Finger Lakes for owner and trainer Mark Eagan on May 28th.

After breaking her maiden as a two year old, **FLATTERING BEA** compiled a record of 8 wins, 7 seconds and 1 third from 31 starts and has career earnings of \$441, 082. She won the Miss Shenandoah Stakes and the Sugar Maple Stakes as well as placed in the Skippat Stakes, Sugar Maple Stakes, Pink Ribbon Stakes, Safely Kept Stakes, West Va. Sec. of State Stakes and Miss Preakness Stakes. Jim has announced that he is retiring his homebred filly and plans to send her to Kentucky to start a new career as a broodmare.
